Missouri-04 Sponsorship and
Worker Race Information for 2009

Once again in 2009 MO-04 will hold a sponsorship race. This race was designed and implemented to entice our members to sell sponsorships. Last year's race went very well and this seems to be a great way to reward those who help our district awards fund by getting sponsors. In 2009, we will not have a worker race but you will still be required to earn 5 worker credits to be eligible for a year end award. The sponsor race will be held at our last point show of the season following the regular NBHA show. There will be no entry fee to participate, but you must earn your entries in order to race. Participation is not mandatory and in no way affects your NBHA points. There was some very significant money up for grabs in last years race. For those of you who did not participate last year, I hope you will consider taking advantage of the opportunity this year. You will help the district and could walk away with some cash to boot! The details of the race are as follows.

Sponsorship Race

1. Members earn (1) one entry into the race for every \$75 worth of sponsorships sold. The \$25 District Awards Fee will count toward your total. You may turn in sponsors until the morning of our last point show.
2. Number of entries are unlimited, but are transferable only within your immediate family (father, mother, son, daughter).
3. The jackpot for this race will be funded at the rate of \$25 per entry, for each \$75 sponsorship sold. If there are 12 entries, the jackpot would be \$300.
4. All money is "added" money since there is no "entry fee" money. The jackpot will be split evenly between divisions for the payout. Percentages within divisions will follow the normal NBHA splits. A sample payout for 12 and 20 entries would be as follows:

12 entries @ \$25 added money = \$300 iackpot

20 entries @ \$25 added money = \$500 jackpot
